Pre-paid discounted tickets

From January 2013 we are introducing bulk pre-paid tickets, offering ten sessions for the price of nine. This little bit of sunshine means \$7.20 per club session. Most tickets will be labelled with name and a twelvemonth expiry date. Of course you can still choose to pay the usual \$8.00 table money and not worry about tickets. Please help our staff by checking the validity of tickets being used at your bridge table.

How do I buy the new tickets?

To bulk buy you'll need to give a full working day's notice. So if you want your tickets on Thursday, you'd need to order them on Tuesday. The tickets are not transferable to another person (including boyfriends, mates, spouses, cousins etc).

Bring a friend, get a free ticket

If you bring a guest to a club session we will give you a free ticket to a future session for your use, which means you could play two sessions for \$3.60 a session. However you must ask for your free ticket at the Club Office within two working days of playing, either in person or by email. Plan ahead and invite your friends now: only 241 playing days in 2013!

Revitalised Website

The website provides more than the printed Programme, and has a full 2013 calendar. Telephone numbers, mobile numbers and email addresses of members are available in a password protected secure area, which is *not* available to the general public. In order to access the controlled area you'll

therefore need a username and password, which is a necessary evil. The Club will be sending out batches of emails over December and January giving you the instructions. The more technical amongst you can download the annual events calendar into your electronic diaries in .ics format, or manipulate the information in .xls format. The contact details supplied are exclusively for the use of Auckland Bridge Club members for non-commercial non-bulk purposes; no other use is permitted.

Lessons

The Club is committed to helping members enjoy and improve their game. We provide day and evening lessons for novices in sessions which are usually held in the upstairs bridge room: a course of ten lessons costs \$120. In addition learners completing a set of Club lessons are gifted a year of free Club membership.
