- I can always count on my partner to remember our agreements
- Partner, if I agree with you then we'd both be wrong
- I don't feel like bridge today, I'd rather pay my bills and do my housework
- I think my annual New Zealand
  Bridge levy is really good value for money



- One thing you can say about Bridge players is that they have tremendous fashion sense
- Our Club is always the right temperature: never too hot nor too cold

#### **Boring but important**

We remind all members that we all want to enjoy our bridge and there are a few simple steps we can all take to help:

- Toss a coin for seating: winners sit North South unless granted a specific exemption by the Director, or if instructed otherwise by the Director
- Please always be polite and welcoming to everybody, and especially to less confident players
- When there are multiple sections running, please sit in the section which best reflects the skills and capabilities of your partnership
- If things go a little wrong, call the Director early, clearly and patiently: the Director will sort it out, you do not need to do this
- Keep announcing your 1 Club and 1
  No trump openings
- o Arrive at least ten minutes before the start of a session
- Give less experienced players plenty of space and time: the Director will also be keeping an eye on their progress
- If you are on lead, lead before writing down contract details: this allows declarer and your partner to consider the hand, and not wait for you
- As interesting as it might be to discuss a previous hand, please resist the temptation to dive into too much detail

# Lionel Wright (1953-2003)

A new arrival to the Club garden is a wooden bench in memory of Lionel Wright, who played at our Club for many years and represented NZ in five world championships. Lionel won the gold medal in the 1990 World Continuous Pairs, and many other titles. He is the inventor of the Lionel Convention, a no trump defence used by some of our more experienced players. The bench was donated by his wife Anisia and their three children.

## **Bridge insults**
