

Double Dummy Declarer Success

This table shows how many tricks a declarer takes compared to double dummy play, given the actual lead. A figure of +1.0 for example would mean that on average the declarer takes one more trick than the double dummy result.



Congratulations to Alex Shan

for winning the Novice Pairs at Congress at Mt Maunganui - See here

The first event exclusively for JIN club members was held at Congress on Sunday. The Novice Pairs was open to all players who had not yet attained their Certificate of Proficiency as at 1 January 2022. Seven tables playing a full 26 board Howell under the guidance of director Babs-Merel de Visser. The event was won by 13 year old Alex Shan from Auckland and his partner Kate Wade from Tauranga with a very healthy score of 61.54%. They were one of only two pairs bidding and making 4 with just 22 point between them, on this hand:



No surprise that Alex is placed very well in the rolling 3-month ladder (Jul-Aug-Sep) for frequency declarer making a contract.

This table is not just about play - it also reflects bidding. There are two good ways to get on this table: (1) by being a great declarer, (2) by being a sound bidder. There are two bad ways to get on this table: (1) by being a chronic underbidder, and (2) by never sacrificing. Regardless of which category you fall into, it is better to be higher than lower in the ranking.
