

Hi Everyone,

This session gave me a few problems because of the way it was run. There were 3 and a half tables in one section playing just 12 boards and 5 tables in another section playing 15 boards.

Technically it should be scored as two separate sections, but I chose not to do that because of the small numbers of scores to compare with and because it is a novice group where I wanted to keep everyone in the same group.

This does lead to some anomalies such as boards 13-15 where only one group has played those boards so a top board is only 8 matchpoints whereas on the other boards a top is 14 matchpoints. There are in fact ways of factoring that, but I didn't want to introduce that because I wanted people to understand the simple basics of the scoring where you get 2 matchpoints for each score you beat and 1 for each score you tie with. Your overall percentage is the number of matchpoints you got divided by the number of matchpoints it was possible for you to get.

Other problems I had were:

The player who scrawled both their name and their number so badly I had to look at last week's results to figure out who they were.

Board 7 where someone wrote 2H by South making 4H and then wrote the score in the E/W column

Board 8 where someone wrote 3H by South and then put a 5 in brackets in the next column but entered no score. Putting a number in brackets is usually used to indicate that the contract failed by that number of tricks. However that seemed really unlikely and as somebody else had a score of 3H making 5H I have assumed that was also the case for them.

On Board 9 someone put an asterisk and said that the N/S hands were switched. This was presumably done at the previous table when someone was not careful putting the cards back in the board. When the cards are in different pockets like that the score achieved cannot be compared with anyone else, so I have to award a slightly above average board to both the N/S and the E/W pairs. That is why there is 60%-60% recorded on that line.

On board 10 someone recorded a contract of 1C by East making 1C and gave them a score of 90. That result is worth on 70 points but as the score for 1C making 2C is 90 the result could have been a mistake in 2 different ways. It could be making 1C for 70 or it could be making 2C for 90. I have assumed that it was making 1C for 70.
