### We have been advised by a contractor of the

Auckland Council that roadworks will take place, beginning approximately 10 October. This will have an impact on parking within the club and the parking in the surrounding streets.

Access from the Remuera Road gate. There is a road safety when cars leave during peak traffic. Cars will not be able to park in the drive or on the yellow dotted lines so fewer car parks available.
