



## Host Responsibility Policy: **Remuera Bowls and Bridge Incorporated**

The Management and Committee of Remuera Bowls and Bridge Incorporated (the "Society") believe we have a responsibility to provide a safe, comfortable, and professional environment where alcohol is served responsibly or not at all.

### 1. Prevention of Intoxication

- **Zero-Tolerance for Impairment:** Members and guests must not be impaired by alcohol or other substances while on the premises.
- **Proactive Monitoring:** Our bar staff and Duty Managers will monitor patrons for early signs of intoxication using the **SCAB** criteria (Speech, Coordination, Appearance, and Behaviour).
- **Service Refusal:** Intoxicated people will not be served and must leave the premises or be moved to a designated safe place (located between the bridge room and the toilets) until they can be safely removed.

### 2. Food Availability

- **Substantial Food:** We will provide and actively promote at least three types of substantial food whenever alcohol is sold or supplied.
- **Accessibility:** A light snack menu is available to all members and guests at the bar. Menus will be clearly displayed to ensure all patrons are aware of their options.

### 3. Low and Non-Alcoholic Options

- **Range of Beverages:** We stock a reasonable range of low-alcohol (1.15% to 2.5% ABV) and non-alcoholic drinks, including tea and coffee.
- **Free Water:** Chilled, clean drinking water is freely available at all times.

### 4. Minors and Identification

- **No Service to Minors:** We strictly prohibit the sale or supply of alcohol to anyone under 18 years of age.
- **ID Policy:** Staff will request photo ID from anyone appearing under the age of 25. Only a NZ Driver's License, Passport, or Kiwi Access/18+ Card will be accepted.
- **Supervision:** Minors are only permitted in supervised areas if accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

## 5. Safe Transport

- **Promotion of Options:** We provide information on local transport, including Auckland Transport buses outside the gate at 273 Remuera Road and the nearby Remuera Train Station.
- **Assistance:** Staff will provide access to a phone to call taxis or designated drivers upon request.

## 6. Management and Environment

- **Certified Managers:** A certified, acting, or temporary Duty Manager will be present at all times alcohol is being sold or consumed.
- **Amenity and Good Order:** We manage noise levels and refuse disposal (e.g., not emptying glass bins late at night) to be considerate of our neighbours.
- **Staff Training:** All staff receive regular training on host responsibilities, including the Serve Wise programme, to ensure compliance with the law.
