Open Format for 6 teams in 2025

- March to July will complete a full round Robin
- August to November is 4 matches. They will be almost a full round robin, because you will only miss one of the other teams.
- Which team you do not play in the second phase will be decided by the standings at the end of the first round robin.
- First will not play sixth
- Second will not play fifth
- Third will not play Fourth
- In other words..... the higher your placing at the end of the first round robin, the lower the placing of the team you do not play in the second stage

Intermediate & Junior Formats for 14 teams in 2025

With 2 matches per session March to August will be one game short of a full round robin. At that stage the 6 teams who are in the final will be decided, and the other 8 teams are in the plate. To differentiate the two fields the top 6 teams will be given 100 extra Victory Points

- There will be 6 matches remaining in September to November
- The first of those matches will be the last team that has not been played in the initial round robin.
- In the final the remaining 5 matches will be a round robin against the other finalists
- In the plate the remaining 5 matches will be against other teams in the plate
